# NOTICE

IS hereby Given, that Payments will commence for Military Services performed in the State of Tennessee, agreeably to the following arrangement, beginning with the Districts of Washington and Hamilton, mounted militia, viz.

On Thursday, October 6, 1796,

With *Serjeant Samuel McCallan*, and his party, for their services from the 20th of January to the 20th of February 1795.  
*Serjeant Daniel McDonald*, &c. from the 10th to the 20th March 1795.  
*Coronet Daniel McDonald*, &c. from the 10 to the 20 May 1795.  
*Lieut. Thomas Mitchell*, &c. from June 10th to July 10, 1795.

On the 7th,

*Coronet Luke Hamilton*, &c. from the 10th to the 20th of June 1795.  
*Capt. William Hamilton*, &c. from the 10th to the 20th January 1795.  
*Major Daniel McDonald*, &c. from the 10th to the 20th September 1795.

Infantry on the 10th,

*Lieut. Robert Hale*, &c. from the 10 to the 20th March 1795.  
*Capt. John Marshall*, &c. from February 10th to April 10th, 1795.  
*Capt. John Baird*, &c. from April 10th to June 10th, 1795.

On the 11th,

*Lieut. Robert Hale*, &c. from April 10th to December 10th, 1795.  
*Do. Do.* &c. from January 10 to March 10th 1796.

Mero District mounted Militia will be continued thus :

*Serjeant Timothy Dunnington*, from the 10th to the 20th January 1795.

On the 14th,

*Lieut. William Hall*, &c. from April 10 to June 10th 1795.  
*James Moore*, &c. from June 10th to July 20th, 1795.  
*Serge Blackmore*, &c. from June 10 to July 20th, 1795.  
*Coronet Joseph Harrison*, &c. from the 10th to the 20th June 1795.

To facilitate and dispatch the business of the foregoing payments, as well as all others that may come before me, I shall divide the time which is allotted for these and for the military claims of 1793 and 1794, as thus :

The claims of 1793 and 1796, as now published will be made from the hours of nine to one o'clock, in the former part of the day. Those for 1793 and 1794, (therefore published by Capt. Rickard) from two to five o'clock in the after part of the day.—Personal claims will be attended to in all the office hours : And for the convenience of the people, as soon as payments are finished in the districts of Washington and Hamilton, I shall go to Nashville to settle those of Mero District.

All claims against the United States are desired be brought forward, and punctual attendance shall be given at my office to dispatch the business.
